Road Safety

Road safety is a topic of utmost importance and imparting knowledge about it to children is essential to ensure their safety and well – being.

To make the students aware of traffic rules and safety measures that we should take while moving on the road "Road Safety Month" was observed in Pawar Public School, Nanded City, Pune.

By employing experiential learning techniques in a play way method, the school aims to equip students with the necessary skills and knowledge to navigate road safety.

Students were also taught a song on traffic signal

On the corner shining bright"

Red means "stop "

Yellow means "slow "

Green means "go"

Through these activities, students not only gained knowledge about road safety but also developed a sense of responsibility towards their own safety as well as others also while on the road.



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
